Constable update >>>

Please remember to keep car doors locked at all times and check that your garage doors are closed. Over the Summer the Bend has experienced several car break ins and a car theft. Most were easy targets due to doors being unlocked and keys left inside!

To early morning joggers, it is recommended to wear reflective clothing for your safety, as there are many vehicles that are driving through the neighborhood.

Please try not to park on the streets to allow for first responders to drive thru easily and ensure house numbers are visible. Also please make sure your house number on the curb is legible. Constable has noticed almost half of the neighborhood's house numbers are faded or non existent.

The Board has approved three flock surveillance cameras. This will take about 4-6 weeks for installation. Mary Nan's office has waived the new service fees for all the cameras. Thank You Mary Nan!!

We had received many inquiries from residents about having the cameras. One will be placed on the East and West side of the Boheme bridge, and one on the West side at Butterfly and Beltway 8 feeder road.

Welcome Fall! **What's going on in Memorial Bend?** In the past six months 4 homes have sold in the Bend. Please welcome your new neighbors at 458 Faust (likely new construction),12731 Memorial Dr., 12847 and 12827 Butterfly Ln. There are currently two lots for sale on Boheme and Electra and 6 homes for sale ranging from \$625,000 to \$1,979,000. Leases have recently ranged from \$3500 to \$9000/month.

What's going on in the real estate market?

At the same time last year, Houston was a seller's market. Right now, Houston is predominantly a neutral market, which means prices tend to be reasonable and homes stay on the market for a typical length of time. Some experts say that we are headed towards a buyers' market, as more houses are being listed and the number of days that a home is on the market has increased a bit.

Besides the supply of homes, mortgage rates play a key role in sales. As the economy experiences disinflation and a cooling labor market, the Federal Reserve may lean towards the continued cutting of interest rates. If the rates continue to drop, some buyers and sellers who have been sitting on the sidelines will re- enter the market.

What are the recent practice changes by the National Association of Realtors?

Buyers represented by an agent are now required to sign a representation agreement to formalize the relationship before touring properties and buyer's agent compensation can no longer be advertised on the MLS. These changes have been made to clarify the cost, value and scope of the services provided by your realtor. Please reach out if you have any questions.
